

CHAPTER 7

PROHIBITING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

SECTION 1: DELETION OF SECTION 7.1 THROUGH 7.14 OF ORD. 1 OF 1980 REPEALED AS OF 1981.

Section 7.1 through 7.14 respectfully and inclusively of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Blanchard, be and hereby are repealed.

SECTION 2:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell, barter, exchange or deal in alcoholic beverages, or for any person or any employee of any person, firm or corporation to sell, barter, exchange, give away, serve, dispense, deliver or otherwise dispose of, or permit to be consumed, alcoholic beverages upon the premises where business is conducted by such person, firm or corporation, within the confines of the incorporated area of the Town of Blanchard.

SECTION 3:

That the terms "Alcoholic Beverages" as used herein shall mean any fluid or any solid capable of being converted into fluid, suitable for human consumption, and containing more than one-half of one per cent alcohol by volume, including malt, vinous, spirituous, alcoholic or intoxicating liquor, beer, port, ale, stout, fruit juices, cider or wine.

SECTION 4:

That whosoever shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than Twenty Five & NO/100 (\$25.00) Dollars nor more than One Hundred & NO/100 (\$100.0) Dollars, or be imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days, or both.
