Whereas, The Blanchard Police Department is in need of police car camera upgrades to keep the police officers and citizens of the Town of Blanchard safe;
Whereas, The Town of Blanchard has its own Culture and Recreation Department, and
Whereas, The Culture and Recreation Department is in need of funds to repair and upgrade the local tennis, basketball, baseball, and softball facilities. Blanchard's citizens and the surrounding area would benefit tremendously from the safer and upgraded area for community recreation;
Now, therefore be it resolved, that we, the Mayor and the members of the Council of the Town of Blanchard do hereby request funding in the amount of THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND & NO/100 (\$35,000.00) DOLLARS, to assist in the police car camera upgrades along with the tennis, basketball, baseball, and softball facilities upgrades of the aforesaid project.
