A RESOLUTION TO APPLY FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (LGAP) ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR THE STATE OF LOUISIANA FOR:
A NEW POLICE CAR AND INSTALLATION OF NEEDED EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, The Town of Blanchard has its own Police Department, and
WHEREAS, The Blanchard Police Department is in need of a new police car as well as the necessary equipment to keep the police officers and citizens of the Town of Blanchard safe;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we, the Mayor and the members of the Council of the Town of Blanchard do hereby request funding in the amount of THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND & NO/100 (\$35,000.00) DOLLARS, to assist in the purchase and installation of the aforesaid project.
